Constitutional Amendment to be Decided

As was discussed at the October meeting, many members are in support of establishing a new meeting night for the club. According to our constitution, there are specific steps to establishing an amendment. Our constitution states:

Article VI...Amendments

The constitution and by-laws may be amended or revised by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote providing the amendment or change has been read at the previous meeting and published in the Newsletter. No discussion of the proposed change will be allowed at the first reading. The complete revision can be moved and approved if there is unanimous consent. If not unanimous, each article and section change will be voted individually and may be debated prior to that vote. If a change fails to pass, revisions to the article or section may be proposed and debated for consideration by the By-Laws Committee. Such revisions will again follow the same reading and voting procedure.

In accordance with this, the amendment was announced at the October meeting, and appears here in the Newsletter. A 2/3 majority vote at the November meeting will establish this amendment.

Currently, our meeting time and date is defined as follows:

SECTION II...TIME OF MEETING

Meetings shall start at 7:30 PM during Daylight Savings Time and at 7:00 PM when off DST, unless announced otherwise at the preceding meeting. Meetings will be held on the first Friday of the month. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the Executive Council or by a majority vote. Regular meetings may be postponed or omitted by a majority vote at any regular or special meeting.

To change the time of the meeting, the following statement is being proposed:

Meetings shall start at 7:00 pm unless announced otherwise at the preceding meeting.

To change the day of the meeting, the following statement is being proposed:

Meetings will be held the last Thursday of the month.

The remainder of Section II would remain unchanged, but moved to its own sub-section.

If both amendments are approved, the constitution would read:

SECTION II...TIME OF MEETING

- a. Meetings shall start at 7:00 pm unless announced otherwise at the preceding meeting.
- b. Meetings will be held the last Thursday of the month.
- c. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the Executive Council or by a majority vote. Regular meetings may be postponed or omitted by a majority vote at any regular or special meeting.

Please be prepared to vote on this amendment at the November meeting.

Annual Elections

November is the month for elections! Vote in your local government elections on November 4th, then for your 2009 WRCC officers at the club meeting on November 7! The following positions will be nominated and elected:

- President
- Vice President/President Elect
- Secretary
- Treasurer

These elected officers will begin their terms in January of 2009, and will serve for one year. Please be prepared to nominate and vote!
